## STANDARD CONDITIONS

1. This permit does not authorise the export of cycads (Cycadaceae), Riversdale heath (*Erica blenna*) or the bulbs and tubers of orchids (Orchidaceae).
2. This permit does NOT authorise the export of any CITES listed flora to anywhere outside the Republic of South Africa .
3. This permit does not authorise the export of indigenous South African flora to be used for bioprospecting purposes as defined by National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act 10 of 2004. Information: 'Bioprospecting, in relation to indigenous biological resources, means any research on, or development or application of, indigenous biological resources for commercial or industrial exploitation. Trade and export of indigenous flora in order to develop and produce products (including, inter alia, new plant varieties) requires a bioprospecting permit from the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment.'
4. The permit holder must keep detailed records of trade for all seed exports made. Records must include the date of export, a list of species exported, the quantities of seed exported, locality information of where seeds were sourced, as well as information on the importing party, including import country, importer name, and purpose of import.
5. These records must be available to CapeNature upon request at any time during the year, as well as upon application for permit renewal.
6. The renewal of permits may depend on compliance of the above conditions.

### INFORMATION:

1. "Export" means to take out of the Western Cape Province to any other place in the Republic or the world .
2. This permit must be used only for protected and unprotected flora - for ENDANGERED flora from N36 must be used.
3. No permit issued by CapeNature exempts the permit holder from complying with any other legislation applicable to the disposal and/or the export of flora.
4. The holder of this permit must have it with him when he exports / imports flora.

## SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. This permit is only valid, in respect of unprotected indigenous flora that has been sourced from a property/person for which the landowner/person had given written permission/document:

2. A copy of this permit and written permission/document indicating the origin of the flora must be in possession of the person responsible for the export of the flora and be available for inspection at any time with each consignment.

3. The permit holder must hand a written document for each transaction, in which the following information is specified:

a) His/her full name and address

b) The purchaser / receiver's full name and address

c) The date of the transaction

d) The name and amount of each species which is sold or donated

4. The permit holder must maintain records of all unprotected flora exported out of the Western Cape with this permit, and submit these documents to CapeNature upon expiry of the permit.
